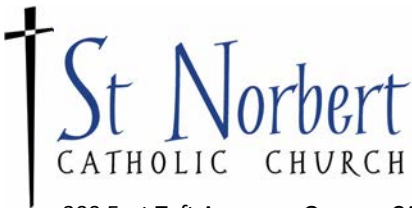

### Reflecting on God's Word

#### Fourth Sunday of Lent

Andrea had done everything her parents had warned her against and had lied to cover it up. But it's impossible to keep a secret in a small town, so she stopped talking to them. When they continued "nagging" her she moved out "forever," telling her parents she "didn't have a family" anymore. Eight months later, broke and lonely, she chanced to see her father on the street. Certain he would condemn her, she turned way—too late. "Hello, Andrea. How have you been?" Andrea could not contain her tears when she heard the words, "Sweetheart, your mom and I would love for you to come home."

What must it have been like for the Israelites to learn that they were free to go home from their exile? No questions asked. All debts forgiven. A new beginning. If we can imagine their joy and gratitude perhaps we can understand more deeply the tremendous gift we have been given in baptism—God's mercy gives us the courage to leave our self-imposed exiles and come home.

Senate Bill 128 to legalize Assisted Suicide has been introduced in the California Senate. This bill is strongly opposed by all the dioceses in California especially the Diocese of Orange, the California Medical Association and organizations for people with disabilities. On March 3 the Diocese of Orange held a meeting on *Dignity and Courage at End of Life* to share why and how to oppose this bill. We, as Orange County Catholics, are asked to contact our State Senators. The diocese has provided an easy path to e-mail our State Senators via the [www.rcbo.org](http://www.rcbo.org) website. On the home page is a turquoise button titled **Tell Our Legislature NO to Doctor Assisted Suicide in California**. 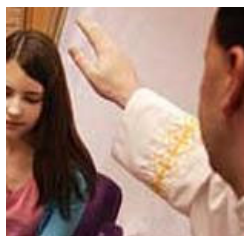

As I collected the candies in a jar weekly, everything dawned on me like a lightning bolt running from the top of my head to my toes that Larry's candy giving and evangelization was the Holy Spirit working through him, letting me know I was in the right place. I truly believe that when I look at the amount of candies in that jar, I realize how many blessings I have received. It is a constant reminder of how nurturing the people of the Catholic faith are.

This journey has been the most rewarding experience in my life and I know that I will soon use my experiences with the Catholic community to evangelize to people in the world seeking God in their lives.
