Do It Now!

Anyone who has ever had to deal with teenagers knows the foot-dragging that can go on over a simple request to do something. “Mark, please take the garbage out;” “Just let me finish this video game!” or “Joanna, you promised to walk the dog;” “Not right now;” “Can’t it wait?” “I’ll do it in a minute!” To their frustration, parents discover that an adolescent “minute” can last for hours, while the young person learns that the great strategy for escaping what one dislikes doing now is promising to do it later. In today’s Gospel Jesus tells of two sons asked by their father to work in his vineyard. The one who said “Later” actually went and did the work, while the other agreed to go but did not. To our surprise, Jesus is not concerned about which son in the story procrastinated, but about the larger issue of how people were responding to his teaching. As we know from many Gospel passages, even Jesus’ closest disciples sometimes had difficulty paying attention to him, and grappled with the meaning of his words. And in the places Jesus visited, the people who thought of themselves as good Jews were reluctant to respond to him or even turned away from him entirely. The people whom the “good” Jews shunned, such as tax collectors and prostitutes, were not only hearing Jesus but immediately following him. They had grasped a great truth: wholeheartedly doing God’s will is of far greater importance than simply following religious laws and commandments, and offers an inner freedom and peace of heart like nothing else. For whatever reason, some of us go through the motions of being a Christian, but never take it to heart. Are you like this? What’s making you drag your feet? Become a real disciple today.

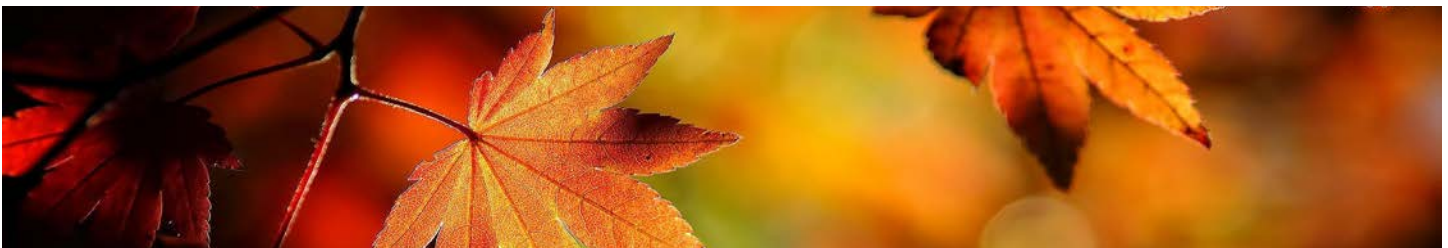

Cualquiera que haya tenido que lidiar con adolescentes sabe que una tarea sencilla que se les pida lo hacen

despacio y sin ganas. "Marcos, por favor saca la basura", "¡Cuando termine este juego de video!", "¡Juanita, prometiste sacar a pasear al perro", "Ahora mismo no, ¿no puede esperar? ¡Dame un minuto!" Los padres descubren frustrados que el "minuto" de un adolescente puede durar horas, mientras que el jovencito o la jovencita aprende la gran estrategia de que puede dejar de hacer lo que no le gusta prometiendo hacerlo más tarde. En el Evangelio de hoy Jesús nos cuenta acerca de un padre que le pidió a sus dos hijos que trabajaran en su viña. El hijo que le contestó: "más tarde", fue quien terminó realizando el trabajo, mientras que el que prometió hacerlo no lo hizo. Nos pudiera sorprender que Jesús no estaba interesado en cuál de los hijos fue el que dejó de hacer el trabajo, sino que su gran interés era ayudar a la gente a responder a sus enseñanzas. Como bien sabemos por los muchos pasajes del Evangelio, aun los discípulos más cercanos de Jesús tenían dificultad y batallaban con el significado de las palabras de su Maestro. En muchos de los lugares que Jesús visitaba el pueblo creía que eran buenos judíos y no sólo se mostraban renuentes a sus enseñanzas sino que muchas veces aun se alejaban del todo de él. La gente que los judíos "buenos" rechazaban, como los cobradores de impuestos y las prostitutas, eran quienes prestaban atención a Jesús y decidían seguirlo inmediatamente; parecían haber entendido una gran verdad, esto es, que hacer la voluntad de Dios es mucho más importante que cumplir leyes y mandamientos religiosos, y que además ofrece una libertad y paz interior inigualables. Para algunos de nosotros ser cristiano es cosa de reglas, sin implicar el corazón. ¿Estás tú entre ellos? ¿Qué es lo que se te hace pesado? Comienza a ser hoy un verdadero discípulo.
