### Is He Here Yet?

Christians in every generation, including modern believers in the New Testament, have hoped that

Jesus would return in their lifetime. Jesus himself promised his disciples that he would return, but warned, "But of that day and hour no one knows, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone" (Matthew 24:36). Those who witnessed Christ's ascension into heaven after his death and resurrection heard the angelic visitors say, "This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven" (Acts 1:11). Saint Paul declared, "We ask you, brothers and sisters, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ . . . not to be shaken out of your minds suddenly . . . that the day of the Lord is at hand" (2 Thessalonians 2:1-2). Nevertheless, over the centuries, certain individuals have claimed to know the exact time of Christ's return, and left many people disillusioned and angry when the event failed to take place. In every age, volcanoes erupt and earthquakes, wars, and epidemics cause death and destruction. Some people wonder if these are not signs of the "end of times." But the more important question for each of us is this: Would you be a better disciple of Jesus if you knew the exact date of his return to earth? If you were absolutely certain, say, that he would return next week, what would you do that you aren't doing now? Make peace with someone with whom you have a conflict? Let go of grudges and resentment? Tell people you care about how much you love them? Repent of your sins? Do special favors? Pray a lot? Throw a party? Stop holding back and do these now. You can't take possessions to heaven, but you can take your deeds.

Children's Liturgy of the Word needs your help! We currently have only one Facilitator and the program will end this year unless more volunteers step forward.



Children's Liturgy of the Word is a vital ministry that serves children in Grades 1 through 4 during the Sunday 9 a.m. Mass. This ministry is "directed to the child's active, conscious and authentic participation" in the Liturgy of the Word, by providing readings adapted to a child's level from the *Lectionary for Masses with Children*, and an explanation of these readings in words that appeal to the children. Children are escorted from the church just before the Liturgy of the Word begins and return to their parents during the Preparation of the Gifts.

Volunteers are needed to be Facilitators (to proclaim the Scripture readings and explain them on a child's level) and Aides (assist the Facilitator in movement of the children to and from the church and keep up with the progress of the Mass). A Leader's Guide walks you through each session, and training is provided for all volunteers.

### ¿Ya Llegó Él?

Los cristianos de todas las épocas, incluso los creyentes modernos del Nuevo Testamento, han abrigado la

esperanza de que Jesús volviera durante la vida terrenal de ellos. El mismo Jesús prometió a sus discípulos que regresaría, pero les advirtió: "Por lo que se refiere a ese Día y cuándo vendrá, nadie lo sabe, ni siquiera los ángeles de Dios, sino solamente el Padre" (Mateo 24:36). Las personas que presenciaron la ascensión de Cristo al cielo después de su muerte y resurrección escucharon a los visitantes angélicos decir: "Este Jesús que les ha sido quitado volverá de la misma manera que ustedes lo han visto ir al cielo" (Hechos 1:11). San Pablo también ha declarado: "Pero hablemos, hermanos, de esa venida de Cristo Jesús, nuestro Señor, . . . les rogamos que no se dejen perturbar tan fácilmente . . . que el día del Señor es inminente" (2 Tesalonicenses 2:1-2). No obstante, durante el transcurso de los siglos, ciertas personas han asegurado saber el tiempo exacto de la segunda venida de Cristo y han dejado a muchas otras personas desilusionadas y enojadas cuando tal acontecimiento no ocurrió. En cada época han habido erupciones volcánicas, terremotos, guerras y epidemias, que han causado muerte y destrucción. Muchos se preguntan si estas cosas no serán signos del "final de los tiempos". Pero la pregunta más importante que debemos hacernos es ésta: ¿Sería mejor discípulo de Jesús si supiera la fecha exacta de su segunda venida a la tierra? Digamos que estás absolutamente convencido de que él volverá la semana próxima, ¿harías algo diferente a lo que ahora haces? ¿Harías las paces con quien tienes un conflicto? ¿Abandonarías tus rencores y resentimientos? ¿Le dirías a las personas cuánto las amas? ¿Te arrepentirías de tus pecados? ¿Harías favores especiales? ¿Rezarías mucho? ¿Darías una fiesta? Pues no esperes más y haz estas cosas ahora. Tus bienes no te los puedes llevar al cielo, pero sí tus buenas obras.
