### World Day of the Poor

In his apostolic letter to close the Year of Mercy, Pope Francis suggested the Catholic Church set aside one day each year when communities can “reflect on how poverty is at the very heart of the Gospel.” He designated this day as the “World Day of the Poor.” It will be celebrated on the thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary time (two Sundays before the season of Advent each year.) The inaugural World Day of the Poor is Sunday, November 19, 2017.

#### Here are 5 Ways You Can Observe the World Day of the Poor

1. **Pray for the Poor:** There are so many people who need our prayers. If you’re overwhelmed and not sure where to start, try praying with your newsfeed. As you see headlines about what’s happening around the world, pause and pray for the people affected by those stories.
2. **Practice the Corporal Works of Mercy:** The Corporal Works of Mercy are drawn from Jesus’ life and teachings. They call us to: feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, shelter the homeless, visit the sick and imprisoned, bury the dead and give alms to the poor. Pope Francis added a new work of mercy: to care for God’s creation. The Corporal Works of Mercy offer a clear model and starting point for how to care for our neighbors in need.
3. **Make Caring for the Poor Part of Your Routine:** Do you buy coffee, chocolate or Christmas gifts? One way to support low-income workers around the world is by buying things you use on a regular basis from organizations that pay a fair wage. If you drink coffee or tea, look for a fair trade label, which means that the farmers who harvest the coffee or tea are paid fairly and work in safe conditions. As you begin your Christmas shopping, consider buying gifts from around the world that are produced and traded ethically.
4. **Learn About the Causes of Poverty and Work to Change Them:** There are many reasons why people around the world are trapped in poverty: lack of jobs, war and climate change that affects what farmers can grow are only a few examples. We can raise our voices together to ask our government to support policies that help address these causes of poverty.
5. **Support the Church’s Outreach to the Poor:** One way to care for the poor around the world is to support the work of Catholic Relief Services, the international humanitarian agency of the Catholic community in the United States. CRS is motivated by the example of Jesus Christ to assist poor and suffering people in more than 100 countries. Learn more and get involved at [crs.org/world-day-poor](http://crs.org/world-day-poor)

## Children's Liturgy of the Word

Children's Liturgy of the Word needs your help! We currently have only one Facilitator and the program will end this year unless more volunteers step forward.



Children's Liturgy of the Word is a vital ministry that serves children in Grades 1 through 4 during the Sunday 9 a.m. Mass. This ministry is "directed to the child's active, conscious and authentic participation" in the Liturgy of the Word, by providing readings adapted to a child's level from the *Lectionary for Masses with Children*, and an explanation of these readings in words that appeal to the children. Children are escorted from the church just before the Liturgy of the Word begins and return to their parents during the Preparation of the Gifts.

Volunteers are needed to be Facilitators (to proclaim the Scripture readings and explain them on a child's level) and Aides (assist the Facilitator in movement of the children to and from the church and keep up with the progress of the Mass). A Leader's Guide walks you through each session, and training is provided for all volunteers.

### Jornada Mundial de los Pobres

En su carta apostólica para concluir el Año de la Misericordia, el Papa Francisco sugirió que la Iglesia Católica reserve un día cada año cuando las comunidades puedan “reflexionar sobre cómo la pobreza está en el corazón mismo del Evangelio”. Él designó este día como el “Día Mundial de los Pobres”. Se celebrará el trigésimo tercer domingo del tiempo ordinario (dos domingos antes del tiempo de Adviento cada año). El día inaugural del Día Mundial de los Pobres es el domingo 19 de noviembre de 2017.

#### Aquí se Presentan 5 Maneras de Observar el Día Mundial de los Pobres

1. **Obrar por los pobres:** Hay tantas personas que necesitan nuestras oraciones. Si se siente abrumado y no está seguro por dónde empezar, intente rezar con su medio de noticias. Al ver titulares sobre lo que está sucediendo en todo el mundo, haga una pausa y ore por las personas afectadas por esas historias.
2. **Practicar las obras de misericordia corporales:** Las obras de misericordia corporales se extraen de la vida y las enseñanzas de Jesús. Estas son: dar de comer a los hambrientos, dar de beber a los sedientos, dar refugio a los desamparados, visitar a los enfermos y encarcelados, enterrar a los muertos y dar limosna a los pobres. ¡El Papa Francisco incluso añadió una nueva obra de misericordia para cuidar la creación de Dios! Las obras de misericordia corporales ofrecen un modelo claro y un punto de partida de cómo cuidar a nuestro prójimo necesitado.
3. **Hacer que el cuidado de los pobres forme parte su rutina:** ¿Usted compra café, chocolate o los regalos de Navidad? Una forma de apoyar a los trabajadores de bajos ingresos en todo el mundo es mediante la compra de cosas que usted usa regularmente de organizaciones que pagan un salario justo. Si toma café o té, busque una etiqueta de comercio justo, lo que significa que los agricultores que ayudaron a cosechar el café o el té fueron pagados de manera justa y trabajaron en condiciones seguras. A medida que comienza sus compras de Navidad, considere la compra de ropa, artesanías y otros regalos de todo el mundo que fueron hechos de manera ética.
4. **Aprender sobre las causas de la pobreza y trabajar para cambiarlas:** Hay muchas razones por las cuales la gente alrededor del mundo está atrapada en la pobreza: la falta de empleo, la guerra y el cambio climático que afecta lo que los agricultores pueden cultivar son sólo algunos ejemplos. Podemos alzar nuestras voces para pedirle a nuestro gobierno que apoye las políticas que ayudan a enfrentar estas causas de la pobreza.
5. **Apoyar el alcance de la Iglesia a los pobres:** Una manera de cuidar a los pobres en todo el mundo es apoyar el trabajo de Catholic Relief Services, la agencia humanitaria internacional de la comunidad católica en los Estados Unidos. CRS es motivada por el ejemplo de Jesucristo de asistir a personas que viven en la pobreza y que sufren en más de 100 países.
