Fifth Sunday of Lent

Romans 8:8-11

Dead from Sin, Alive with Spirit

As Lent nears its end, we become more mindful of our sins. We have promised to renew our hearts throughout this season. We have accepted a spirit of penitence. The elect, who are preparing for baptism at Easter, have received our prayers in scrutiny rites that purify their intentions and turn their hearts more firmly towards Christ.

But at this stage of Lent, we may be even more aware of our sin. Perhaps we have not been completely faithful to our Lenten resolutions. Perhaps we feel more strongly the difficult challenge to overcome bad habits that have taken years to form. Lent offers promise, but it sometimes causes discouragement.

Sin is no stranger to the human condition. But sin is not our natural condition. Through baptism, we are children of God.


St. Paul tells the Romans not to feel disappointed by their experience of sin, because the Spirit of God is much more powerful. "If Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the spirit is alive because of righteousness."

God's Spirit raised Jesus from the dead. The same Spirit dwells within us. The same Spirit gives life to our bodies prone to death.

If Lent has made us more aware of our sin, it should also make us more aware of God's love. God's Spirit reaches us, holds us, and lifts us high—in spite of our sin.

Journeys of Faith

Two of our Candidates, baptized in other Christian Faith traditions, will become fully one with the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Here are their stories:

Rick Bazant

I first have to thank my wife, Sara, with whom I began this journey in my Catholic faith over 12 years ago. One of the first members of the church I had regular contact with was Father Bill McLaughlin. He was my wife's pastor while she attended UCI and performed our wedding ceremony. He was one of the most supportive and welcoming people I had the pleasure to meet while exploring my own spiritual journey. After we were married, Sara and I began to regularly attend Mass at St. Norbert parish. Our former pastor Monsignor John and Father Pat have both been supportive guides with my religious formation. My final decision came when my daughter entered the second grade at St. Norbert School and started the process for her First Communion. The process of learning and developing my own Catholic transformation has been enlightening and supportive. In a small way, I have felt part of Jesus' community and now it was my way to finish this process. I would like to thank my sponsor Ed Bick for his weekly support, encouragement and friendship. He truly demonstrates the supportive members of this wonderful parish. A recent passage I came across demonstrates my journey. Luke 15:32: "But now we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found." My thoughts and feelings reflect upon God's grace of spirit and his words that have become my true salvation. I humbly stand before you and proclaim your love and glory in Jesus' name.

Mike Falske

I was not active in attending Church since I was a kid. I was baptized Lutheran. I got married in the Catholic Church. My wife has always been Catholic. We have a son and we want him to grow up in a Christian home. We have been attending Mass together for about 7 years. During that time I have started to feel closer to God, so I decided it was time to take the next step. For me the next step was to participate in the Eucharist. I joined RCIA classes.

Some obvious changes I feel, see or notice in myself are I am not as quick to judge others as before. I feel my heart is softer. I read somewhere before (open your heart) and I feel mine has opened. I have always thought of myself as a good person, but now at home we give thanks to God for our blessings (food, health, job, home and each other). I talk to my son about God and prayer. Now we are more of a Christian family.

Some days I have words or ideas coming to my head, when my mind starts to wander down the wrong road (no matter how small) the words of Jesus come to my mind to send me down the right road. I have never confessed my sins, but I am anxious to do that. This would be another large step in my journey. These are some of the changes that have occurred in me. I am sure as time goes by there will be more changes. I am looking forward to take the Eucharist to be one with God.

I would also like to thank my sponsor, Marty McNamara, for donating his time and knowledge to me. I do not have a lot of knowledge about the Bible, so I know it has been challenging for him. Thanks again, Marty. Also, I would like to thank the RCIA team for their time and knowledge they shared with our class.

Al igual que Lázaro, cuyo sepulcro se convirtió en vientre de vida nueva, también nosotros tenemos una vida "nueva" y más rica para vivir en el Espíritu de la fe, la gratitud, el amor y la esperanza.
