### Doing Good, Feeling Good

Doing the right thing does not always feel good. You might take a stand for what you believe. Or you go out of your way to assist someone in need. But even in these circumstances, something can still go wrong. Others do not appreciate your sacrifice. You suffer ridicule. You experience loss. You know it is right to do good, but unfairly you do not always feel good.

The First Letter of Peter says, "If you are patient when you suffer for doing what is good, this is a grace before God. For to this you have been called."

The good we do is already a sign of our progress in the spiritual life, even if it does not feel that way. In the past, we may have avoided what is good if it seemed to threaten peace. We might have kept quiet about injustice in the workplace, the offenses of a neighbor, or the inappropriateness of derisive humor. Our silence gave consent. We were like sheep going astray.

But in Christ we know better. We do what is right even if it is unpopular. We speak up for the oppressed. We take time to defend human rights. We act with boldness we did not know before. We obtain this strength for doing good from the Shepherd of sheep, who guides and protects the flock.

Faith in Christ brings comfort and courage. It makes us feel loved, confident, and strong to suffer for doing what is good, even when it is unpopular.

## A Message from the Diocese of Orange and the State Bar of California

The Diocese of Orange is working with the State Bar of California in an effort to protect our parishioners and local immigrant communities from fraudulent and predatory immigration and naturalization service offerings tied to federal Immigration Reform.

Luis J. Rodriguez, State Bar president, has made this fraud prevention project one of his priorities, which the diocese supports. Mr. Rodriguez states in a memo released to partner organizations: "Please be aware that at this time there is no Immigration Reform. Do not give your hard-earned money to a lawyer or notary public for this purpose. It is against the law for them to take money for Immigration Reform because it does not exist at this time."

## Wondering Why

Sheep and shepherds are a frequent image in the scriptures. While seeing shepherds caring for their animals was an every day occurrence in Biblical times, and in some countries is still today, it is perhaps difficult to imagine for people living in Orange County who might have seen sheep only in a small pen at the county fair. Why should this idea of a poor laborer and a flock of not overly bright animals be such an example of God and his people?

The 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm, which might have been written by King David as long ago as 1000 B.C., uses this image in beautiful ways. In it the psalmist says that God is his shepherd. It is God who leads him through his days, and directs him to places where fresh water and green grass refresh his soul. God does not lead his faithful ones into danger, but rather protects them when they find themselves in dark places. As a shepherd uses his rod and staff to protect the sheep from wild animals or to redirect them when they start to stray, the psalmist finds courage in knowing that God also is his protector in times of danger and is his defender.

The psalmist reminds us that God provides a banquet for his people, even while their enemies are watching, and in abundance pours his blessing upon them and fills their cups with joy. The psalm ends with a blessing of assurance that goodness and kindness will always be with the faithful one.

In ancient Israel, some of the leaders were not faithful to God's direction. The prophet Ezekiel, in chapter 34 of his book, again uses the image of sheep to address this situation. He says that these leaders have been negligent shepherds, risking their flocks for their own benefit, growing fat while their flocks starve, neglecting the needs of the sheep. In this prophecy, God says through Ezekiel, "I myself will pasture my sheep; I will give them rest. The lost I will seek out, the strayed I will bring back, the injured I will bind up, the sick I will heal."

In John's Gospel, Jesus refers to himself as the "Good Shepherd." God had fulfilled the prophecy of Ezekiel, he has himself come to shepherd his sheep. It is Jesus who seeks the lost and strayed, who brings healing to the sick, and wholeness to those who have been injured. Jesus, the shepherd who is always faithful, who leads us as the psalmist promised, to flowing waters in Baptism, pours oil upon us in Confirmation, Holy Orders, and Anointing, invites us the great banquet of the Eucharist, and restores peace to our souls.

God has kept his promise. He has come to shepherd his people. Jesus is the Shepherd of all who recognize his voice and follow him.



## Ministerio Hispano

### Reflexionemos sobre la Palabra de Dios

Al terminar el día los pastores traen a sus ovejas a un mismo redil guiándolas a través de una puerta que había sido custodiada durante la noche. Los pastores le ponían nombre a sus ovejas y las llamaban al amanecer, guiándolas de nuevo al pasto. Ya que las ovejas reconocían la voz de su pastor no se confundían con las ovejas que pertenecían a otros.

El que los pastores le dieran nombre a cada una de sus ovejas nos deja clara la diferencia entre un buen pastor y un extraño. El buen pastor se preocupaba no sólo de su rebaño en general, sino de cada oveja en particular. Ellas lo conocían a él y él las conocía a ellas. Las ovejas "nunca siguen a un extraño, sino que huyen de él, porque su voz les resulta desconocida" (Juan 10:5).

Existen dos palabras en griego para significar "bueno": *agathos* y *kalos*. *Agathos* se refiere a la bondad moral, como ser una "buena persona". *Kalos* quiere decir ser "bueno en" o "para" algo. Ciertamente Jesús es el Buen Pastor en ambos sentidos, pero la palabra que se usa aquí es *kalos*, a fin de enfatizar que él es "bueno para" pastorear.

Jesús conoce a sus ovejas por nombre, las dirige hacia un lugar seguro al caer la noche y las regresa al pasto. Él estuvo dispuesto a entregar su vida por ellas. Y lo más consolador es que vino entonces y viene ahora para darnos vida y vida en abundancia. Esta imagen nos desafía a todos los que hemos sido llamados a ser pastores en la Iglesia de hoy a ser buenos pastores y ser buenos para pastorear.

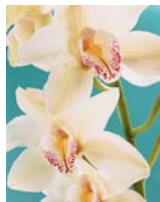

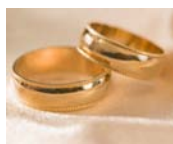

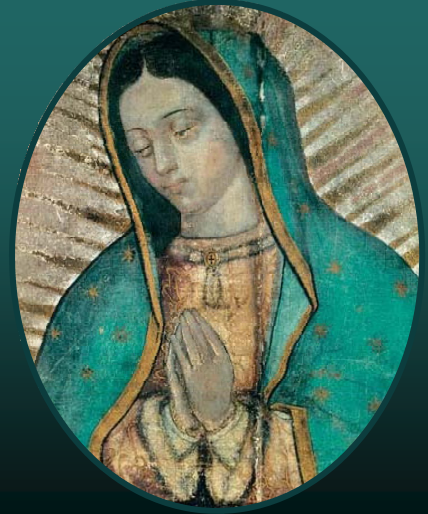
